MND today announces the signing of a partnership with the Val d'Isère Sports Club (CDS Val d'Isère), which organises sporting events at the French alpine resort of Val d'Isère.

Via its ski slope protection subsidiary MBS, MND will be the official technical partner of CDS Val d'Isère for the coming four seasons. MND Group products will play a crucial role in the various competitions organised at the resort.

This partnership makes MBS the official supplier of the *Critérium de la Première Neige*, an FIS World Cup women's and men's ski racing event held in December.
